Investment Objectives

The Fund will seek to provide participants with an assessment of th capital invested in the medium/long term primarily by investing in the shares of companies listed on national regulated markets. The Fund must permanently determine a minimum of 85% of its global net value invested in shares.

Investor Profile

The Fund is suitable for Customers with a dynamic risk profile, with tolerance to withstand possible capital devaluations, as well as for investors with stable equity situation, who wish to capture the returns provided by the national stock market.

Manager comments

European markets continued to record a positive discrepancy compared to their global peers in March. Tax wars and possible abandonment from Ukraine to its own faith by the Trump administration triggered a turnaround in German fiscal policy, with an initial focus on investment in defense and infrastructure.

Investors are now beginning to envision greater cooperation in Europe, at various levels, to resolve economic issues that take a long time to be addressed. The MSCI Index Europe fell 1.3%, while the MSCI World, S&P500, MSCI Asia ex-Japan indices and Nikkei 225 depreciated 6.7%, 8.5%, 1.7% and 1.8%, respectively, in Euros. The domestic market was among those that recorded the best performance, not devaluing in the month. The strong appreciation by Mota Engil, REN and CTT offset the devaluation from Jerónimo Martins and EDP Renewables.

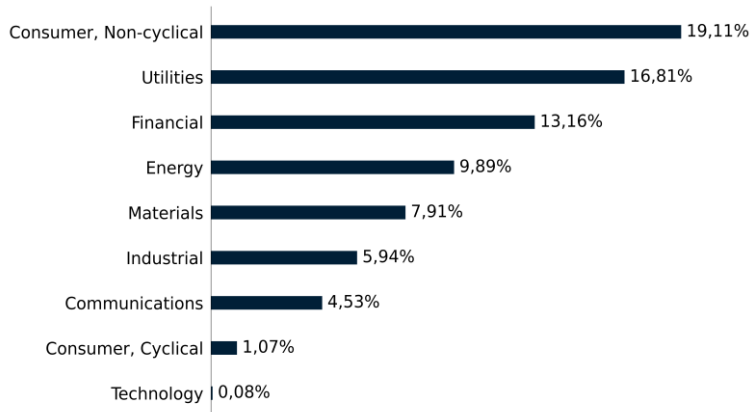
Fund Evolution
